- ❖ **Theme**– The course shall provide a platform to conduct research projects leading to practical fulfillment of M.Sc. or B. Tech. or M. Tech. Degree.
- ❖ **Duration**– 4-6 Months (November 2026 to April 2027).
- ❖ **Last Date of Application** – 29 Oct 2026.
- ❖ **Date of Examination** – 31 Oct 2026.
- ❖ **Selection will be done on merit basis Eligibility** – Students of M.Sc., B. Pharm., M. Pharm., B.E., B. Tech., M. Tech. / M. Tech. Integrated in subject of Microbiology, Biotechnology, Chemistry, Biochemistry, Life science, Zoology, Botany and any Allied Science registered under any recognized University.
- ❖ **Registration/ Admission**– Dually filled application form should be submitted along with following documents,
 - 1) Recommendation Letter from Principal/Head of the Department of the College/University.
 - 2) Photocopy of Graduation Mark sheet OR in case students enrolled for Integrated M.Sc./M. Tech. course previous semester mark sheet.
